Training and Readiness Net PREAMBLE

Identify First

“This is _____” (*insert callsign here*), *Net Control for the Coshocton County Skywarn Network, Training and Readiness Net.*

The primary purpose of the **Training and Readiness Net** is to provide an opportunity for Weather Spotters to test their equipment and the transmission path to the Repeater System. This Weather Net is conducted each **Monday evening after the ARES net on 145.230 at 9:00 PM** during Severe Weather Season, roughly March through the end of September.

(Announce any current Watches or Warnings)

This is a Directed Net, and this Station shall act as Net Control.

The Net begins with Net Control requesting announcements and priority traffic.

Are there any stations experiencing SEVERE WEATHER at this time?

Is there a station that can monitor the _____ repeater and act as a Liaison?

Station's wishing to join the Net at this time, give your callsign and location. Mobiles and Portable Check-ins are taken first, then any other Coshocton County.

At this point there will be an on-air Training feature.

Maintain net operation by announcement every ten minutes:

“This is _____ (*insert callsign*) **Net control for Coshocton County Skywarn.**

Are there any reports of SEVERE WEATHER at this time?

Any additional stations wishing to check in, give your callsign and location.

When closing the Net it is considered proper to thank all stations participating and the repeater owner/operators/trustees for its use.
