Notes on stitching out these designs...they were designed for woven fabrics, but will work on knits IF you use a spray adhesive to hold the knit from shifting in the hoop and I would also use a lightweight CUTAWAY either ironed on like the Pellon SF101 mentioned below or with a spray adhesive like 505. Use a clear topper also for best results. I hate puckers with a vengeance! I recently learned of a product, Pellon SF101, that is a woven cotton iron-on stabilizer...it is not heavy, but it sure does the job of creating a lovely smooth finished design. It does not make the fabric stiff at all...quilt blocks are still soft and flexible. I tested all of these designs using this.. Thank you for your purchase! Enjoy!
